Should an LDP camper exhibit disruptive, unsafe, or violent behavior, his/her parent or guardian will be asked to pick-up, or arrange for the camper to be picked up at parent or guardian's expense from Mo-Ranch immediately. No refunds will be given under these circumstances.
