n January of 2018, the staff of Presbyterian Mo-Ranch Assembly welcomed The Rev. Kathy Anderson as its chaplain and program director. Kathy is a native Texan who spent her childhood and formative years in Victoria, Texas. She grew up in the First Presbyterian Church of Victoria and first ventured to Mo-Ranch with the FPC youth group 35 years ago. In fact, her connection to Mo began even before her conscious memory. Her grandparents, Glenn & Lucile Anderson, were involved in the early development years of Mo-Ranch. They were longtime resident volunteers during the tenure of Otis Moore and always held Mo-Ranch in high regard—a value they passed along to their family and granddaughter. Her grandfather even built some of the original sleds for the slide!

Over the course of her ministry, Kathy has been a friend of, and frequent visitor to, Mo-Ranch, attending conferences, youth events, church retreats and Presbytery meetings.

Kathy brings 20 years of ordained ministry experience to her new role and seven years of executive director leadership, formerly serving as the head of John Knox Ranch, the camp and retreat center of Mission Presbytery. A pastor at heart, she has served on the pastoral staff of Mt. Washington Presbyterian Church in Cincinnati, Ohio, and Westminster Presbyterian Church in Austin, Texas. In addition to congregational ministry, Kathy also served in the mission field as a Young Adult Volunteer in Guatemala and as part of the Presbyterian Church (USA) Global Ministry national staff in Louisville, Kentucky.
