Youth Conference Participant Covenant

The mission of Presbyterian Mo-Ranch Assembly is to foster growth in God through Jesus Christ by sharing its unique living, learning, Christian environment.

More than a set of "rules" or "guidelines" a covenant between conference participants remembers our Biblical foundations. God who created all that was, is, and is to come made covenant to love and care for us at all times. Following God's lead, we covenant with one another when we gather in community in order to make a safe and caring place for playing, studying, worshiping and living.

I promise to participate in the building and caring for community by:

- Being fully present and participating in all scheduled activities
- Showing respect for conference participants, staff, other guests as well as the ranch itself by:
 - O Asking before entering a housing facility that is not my "home" for the week
 - Abiding by the smoke-free building policy
 - O Being responsible for my belongings and caring for the property of others
 - o Refraining from throwing things off either catwalk
 - o Swimming in groups, at designated times
 - o Refraining from jumping or diving from the highway bridge or the dam
 - o Using the Ropes Course only while Mo-Ranch staff are present
- Dressing appropriately by wearing clothing that allows me to participate fully in the activity at hand, keeping in mind that I am attending a church youth conference and that I represent my family, congregation and community at all times by what I say, do, and wear. I will not bring clothing that advertises alcohol or tobacco or other illegal substances; nor which contain language/pictures that demean or ridicule someone's gender, sexuality or ethnic origin.
 - O Swim suits must fit in such a way that they stay on my body. Swim trunks should be worn at the waistline and not be shorter than mid-length (6"-7" inseam).
 - o Water activities/recreation events: All participants are expected to wear t-shirts covering the torso/with sides.
- Abiding by laws prohibiting the possession or use of illegal drugs and which prohibit the possession or use of alcohol by persons under the age of 21. (As an adult over the age of 21, I will abstain from consuming alcohol during the conference). I will take medication prescribed to me by a doctor only as directed.
- Refraining from sexual activity while at Mo-Ranch.
- Caring for the environment in which we are all learning, playing and living by putting trash and recyclables in to the appropriate containers; using my audio devices in such a way that they do not disrupt others; watching the ways I express myself through words and actions; and minimizing technological distractions (texting, phones, tablets).
- Leaving at home items such as: skateboards, scooters, roller blades, firearms, knives, weapons of any kind, incendiary devices (matches, lighters, fireworks and so on), laser pointers, or other items that could disrupt the conference or other Mo-Ranch guests.
- Practicing the "Rule of Three" (two youth and one adult, or two unrelated adults and 1 youth) while in classrooms, walking about the ranch, and in housing.

Youth Conference Sponsor Responsibilities

The mission of Presbyterian Mo-Ranch Assembly is to foster growth in God through Jesus Christ by sharing its unique living, learning, Christian environment.

Adult sponsors play a key role in the success of each of our conferences.

- Each group must send a minimum of one adult for every five youth. Churches must send sponsors of the same gender as those youth who will be participating.
- In order to maintain a ratio, adult sponsors may be asked to supervise youth from another congregation up to a maximum of five youth. Confirmation of registration is dependent on the availability of sufficient adult sponsors for each gender and/or the gender requirement.
- Churches with small congregations that find it difficult to meet the sponsor/participant ratio should contact the Mo-Ranch Program Office (programs@moranch.com) for assistance in securing appropriate supervision for their youth.
- Mo-Ranch has a zero-tolerance policy regarding child abuse (including, but not limited to physical, emotional or sexual abuse).
- Mo-Ranch sponsors must also abide by the Rule of Three (two youth and one adult) or (two unrelated adults and one youth) to ensure safety for all guests. No adult shall be left alone with a minor; therefore, sponsors will not be housed in the same hotel room as youth participants. A reasonable ratio of adult workers will be maintained in each situation involving the supervision of minors.
- Mo-Ranch staff and volunteer directors will engage in ongoing supervision and may make unannounced visits to classes and other program sites during the conference.
- Sponsors are responsible for the behavior of their youth at all times.
- Sponsors are asked not to bring non-participant children to the conference.
- Each sponsor is expected to participate fully in all conference activities and to facilitate home group devotions.
- Sponsors are responsible for ensuring that their youth attend all conference activities.
- Sponsors are expected to maintain a positive attitude because it will make a difference in the atmosphere of the conference. Your attitude has a direct effect on your youth and on your own enjoyment. You are an important role model!
- Sponsors are expected to see that youth observe afternoon rest times and lights-out each night, eat regularly, drink plenty of water, and remember to use sunscreen.
- Sponsors are not allowed to leave Mo-Ranch once your group has checked-in (unless for emergencies).
- In the case where a youth participant becomes ill/injured and requires medical attention, youth sponsors are the designated responsible adult(s) to transport/accompany the young person to the clinic or hospital. Mo-Ranch staff and/or conference leadership will provide guidance and assistance with the young person's situation (e.g. responding with First Aid, providing directions to urgent care or the ER, etc.), but youth sponsors remain the primary care-giver for the youth.
